# **Primary Function**

The Developer is responsible for developing amazing software and verifying that changes made to extensions are correct according to requirements, user needs, and expectations. This is done through adherence to the distinct maintenance and new product development processes. They communicate with clients and QA to ensure clarity of requirements. They work with their Project Lead to provide estimates broken into manageable SMILEstones. They perform Code Reviews according to PlatinumEdge code standards.



## Responsibilities

- Engages in developing high quality new products following PlatinumEdge code standards.
- Able to test their own work against written requirements.
- Works directly with the clients as needed to clarify requirements and documents information on the tickets.
- Communicates disagreements with QA in a friendly manner to reach an agreement according to customer requirements and a focus on quality.
- Works with Project Lead and Account Manager to ensure changes to scope are recognized and estimated.
- Works with Project Lead to plan large changes in a scalable and maintainable way.
- Brings up roadblocks and red flags to Project Lead as early as possible.
- Executes smoke tests as needed by QA for each build.
- Creates Merge Requests for changes according to the process.
- Performs Code Reviews for other developers.
- Reports time on projects accurately, informatively, and timely.
- Helps other developers when they have questions.
- Follows Developer Processes for Branching, Maintenance, Project, Merge Requests, and any future processes added to the Developer Documents folder in the Shared drive.
- Adheres to Billable Time for Developers.
